# **Education, Awareness and Support Programmes**

#### **Insights Programme**

A 12 week personal development recovery group for women who have experienced domestic abuse. Facilitated by expert psychotherapists in a confidential and safe setting, this programme will help the woman identify life-long patterns of abuse, set realistic goals and learn new techniques towards self-determined change.

#### **Insights for Mothers**

A 10 week programme to help mothers understand how their relationships have impacted both themselves and their children. Aided by highly experienced psychotherapists in a confidential atmosphere, mothers will learn to understand their children's challenging behaviours, and how to support and communicate effectively with them.

#### **TLC Kidz**

Clare Haven Services, in partnership with Barnardos, runs a 12 week psychoeducational programme for both children (aged 5-18) and mothers; both groups run concurrently. It is an early intervention approach for children and young people who have experienced domestic violence and abuse.

#### **Prevention Programmes for Schools**

We provide bespoke educational prevention programmes to meet the needs of post primary schools. These can be informal talks or structured programmes on Domestic Abuse and healthy relationships.

#### **Awareness Presentations**

We deliver awareness talks to voluntary and community groups, statutory agencies and professionals working in front-line services.

## Children and Young People's Support Services

- Children & Young People's Service offers a childcare service for children 0-17 years that provides a safe space to explore and play while establishing warm and responsive relationships & connections
- Supporting the child or young person from within the Refuge and Outreach services around the experiences they disclose
- Supporting Mothers to recognise the impact that Domestic Abuse has had or is having on her child
- Supporting Mothers to speak to their child about the hurting and fighting that occurred in the home and how to talk to their child about separation or the changes that are occurring within their family
- Supporting Mothers to liaise with the child's school, early years' or school aged care service and to share with them the child's experiences of Domestic Abuse and how that may impact their time in schools/ services.
- Supporting Mothers to engage with Tusla social workers where there are child protection concerns.
- C&YP service also supports Mothers with childcare for court dates, support appointments, meetings with solicitors etc.
- Referrals to play therapy, adolescent psychotherapy & therapeutic horse riding as appropriate
